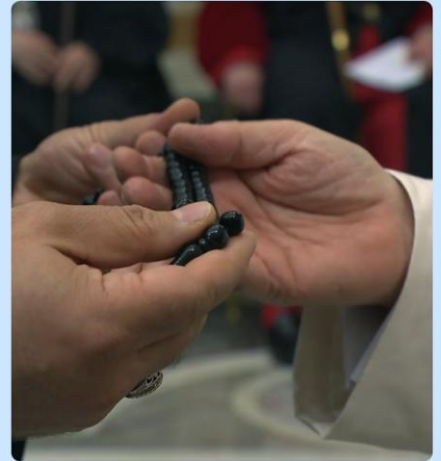

Theological Institute for everyone

It is divine providence that the Catholic Theological Institute of Singapore (CTIS) is housed in the same building as the St Francis Xavier Major Seminary (SFXMS), which was once the site of Assumption Primary School.

CTIS, which moved into the grounds of St Joseph’s Church in 2018, was established in 2013 by then Archbishop William Goh. The mission was to provide systematic theological formation to enable laypeople to collaborate with religious and priests in the work of evangelisation. From 2016, laity and seminarians have shared a common curriculum.

Since the original CTIS building in the Catholic Centre in Waterloo Street was needed for other archdiocesan organisations, the Archdiocese decided on the move to Bukit Timah.

At the groundbreaking ceremony of the CTIS-SFXMS building in 2016, Archbishop Goh explained that changing circumstances made it necessary for the joint location.

First, it was unfeasible to run the seminary for only a few seminarians in Punggol. Second, the easily accessible Bukit Timah site allows seminarians to be closer to the laity. Third, Catholic schools nearby would provide opportunities for more faith-formation collaboration.

Fourth, proximity to the Trinity Theological College would enable laity and seminarians to learn more about other Christian beliefs. Fifth, there would be greater spiritual formation of laypeople as they would attend lectures with ‘future diocesan priests and religious’.

CTIS provides the Certificate in Theology, with the COVID pandemic paving the way for online Zoom lectures and faith formation sessions. The Certificate enables students to know more about the Catholic faith, with courses in Introduction to the Bible, Salvation History, Christian Philosophy, Foundational Theology, Foundations in Moral Theology and The Second Vatican Council.

The Certificate runs over two semesters of full-time study in one academic year while part-time study is available over six semesters.

Interested applicants for the CTIS programme need to fill in an application form; seek recommendation from a Catholic priest; and provide a certified true copy of highest education qualification received.

CTIS has almost 1000 graduates to-date. Many of the graduates have gone on to serve the Church in the various parish ministries. Some graduates are from the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA).

Most students are from Singapore, but some are from the region, for example, Lillian Law from the St Joseph’s Private School in Kuching and Bernadette Rebecca Tsui who completed the online Certificate programme in Mandarin while in Sydney, Australia.

One graduate, Olivia Vong, advanced from teaching to mission work as a youth minister in the Archdiocese of Glasgow, Scotland. There is also the CTIS Alumni Association that organises roadshows and spiritual talks as part of continuing education.

CTIS is indeed for everyone anywhere wishing to grow in faith.
