Outdoor Stations of the Cross

Every now and then, you can see visitors snapping photographs of the life-size statues at the Stations of the Cross in our church. The visitors could have been guided to our Stations by Trip Advisor, which states that our ‘historical landmark’ is ‘definitely worth a visit’.

Our 15 Stations are indeed unique, attracting even parishioners from various Singapore churches especially during Lent. The Stations were launched in two stages. First in 1991, the late Archbishop Gregory Yong blessed the 14 Stations lining the perimeter of the church; the Stations were also restored in 2008. Second in 2019, Archbishop William Goh blessed the 15th Station, Garden of the Resurrection, close to the Rosary Garden.

The idea for the 14 Stations started after the government issued a notice in 1988 to acquire the front land of the church for drainage and road widening. Realising the need to beautify church land productively, especially along the drainage at Upper Bukit Timah Road and up to the Chestnut Drive cemetery, the parish decided to have ‘St Joseph’s Mount Calvary’ to commemorate the passion and death of Jesus Christ. Mr Lee Seng Huat, President of the Solidarity of St Joseph’s (Dying Aid Association), proposed the idea of having Stations like those he had seen in Lourdes in 1989. After searching for suitable and affordable statues, the Solidarity members found the 46 life-size statues and 11 crosses in Cochin, India. Members and local sculptors took a year to assemble every Station accurately. The project cost about \$300,000, with funding from over 100 members.

Planning for the 15th Station started in mid-2017, with architect Victor Tay designing the Scripture-based Resurrection Station. The initial plan was to source the sculptures from Florence, Italy, but Chinese sculptor Joseph Yuan from Hebei, China, carved the original sculptures from scratch rather than use replicas. The process of designing, carving the white marble and delivery took a year.

The three sculptures of the 15th Station represent the Risen Lord, the Angel of Praise and the Angel of Adoration. The Risen Lord holds a flag with a red

cross to symbolise Christ’s Resurrection as victory over death. The Angel of Praise sounds a trumpet to proclaim the Lord’s risen glory. The Angel of Adoration has clasped hands to convey peaceful trust in Christ.

There are reasons for the white marble of the 15th Station and the gypsum cement of the 14 Stations. The marble symbolises that our resurrected bodies are different from the mortal bodies represented in cement. Unlike the 14 Stations, the 15th Station does not have a stone backdrop to convey that the Risen Lord is unrestrained. The bamboo backdrop connects with Bamboo Hill, which was once a name for our church location.

There is also history in the Stations of the Cross in churches. Though the Way of the Cross originated in the Via Dolorosa route in Jerusalem 2000 years ago, Franciscan Friars erected Stations in Europe in the 15th century to enable more worshippers to reflect on the Lord’s Passion. By the end of the 17th century, meditation on the Passion of Our Lord spread to many countries. In 1731, Pope Clement XII standardised the number of Stations at 14 as Christian communities in different locations had five, seven, nine, 11, 15 and 36 Stations. In 1975 and 1991, Pope Saint Paul VI and Pope Saint John Paul II approved Scripture-based 14 Stations. Pope John Paul II also added the 15th Station to convey triumph at the Resurrection of Jesus. The 15 Stations emphasise that the Paschal Mystery of Christ is an integrated devotion.

When we journey through the 15 Stations, we reflect on the different moments of Good Friday – from condemnation of Christ to His Resurrection. The plaque on the 15th Resurrection Station gives hope to all of us: *“The Lord is truly risen, Alleluia! To him be glory and dominion for all eternity. He is with us always, until the end of time.”*

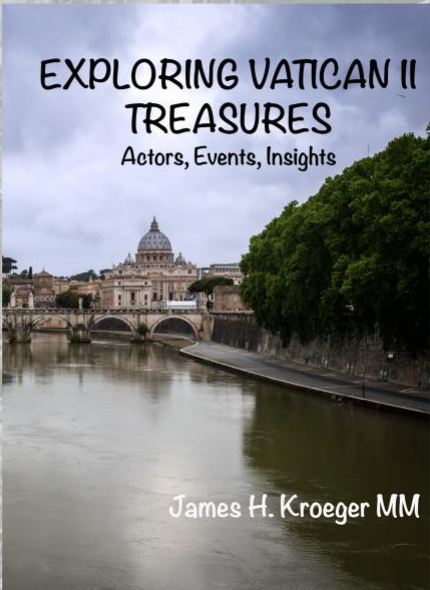
