



The migrant's ministry - Parish Befrienders Group (PBG) - of St. Joseph's Church is seeking for new members as part of its expansion.


The objective of our Ministry is to befriend newcomers to our parish so that they feel welcome and feel part of parish family. We have several exciting programmes for both young and old.



Few issues are as controversial as sexuality today. Many ideas, new and old, compete for our attention in the marketplace of ideas.


Yet, sexuality has always been important for the Church. Why is that? What is its purpose in God's plan? What are some of the controversial topics? How can we address them?
