My dear Parishioners

Priests Annual Retreat (4 – 8 Jul)

This week, the priests will be having our annual Priests Retreat from Mon 4 Jul to Fri 8 Jul. During this time, there will be no Masses but we will have Communion Services instead.

We ask for your prayers that we will remain true to our vocation, and serve God's people with humility and love.

Continue to be vigilant

With the recent rise in COVID-19 cases, we are all strongly urged to continue to be socially responsible by observing the prevailing safe management measures (SMMs) and avoid social interactions if we experience fever or respiratory symptoms, or test positive for COVID-19.

Masking up while indoors will continue to be required, as a key line of defense. The current set of Vaccination-Differentiated SMMs (ie parishioners must be fully vaccinated) for Masses with a capacity more than 500 will remain unchanged. Let us all do our part to keep our Parish safe.

Introducing our Ministries

We will be introducing our Ministries every month to enable you to appreciate the different roles that they perform. Every function is important as we are all part of one body – the Church.

We will start off by introducing our Liturgical Committees as they are an integral part of our Masses. There are 6 Liturgical Ministries viz :

The role of the Liturgical Ministries is to ensure that the assembly is led to full, conscious, and active participation in the liturgy. Their work is essential for the smooth execution of the complicated liturgies of the Roman Catholic Church.

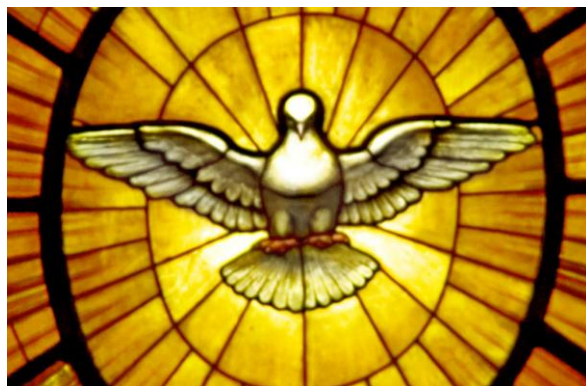

Confirmation Mass (Sun 3 July @ 11.30 am)

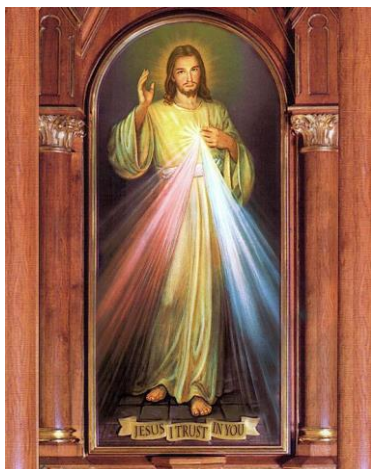
Sixty-nine (69) confirmands will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sun 3 Jul at the 11.30 am Mass.

Few issues are as controversial as sexuality today. Many ideas, new and old, compete for our attention in the marketplace of ideas.


Yet, sexuality has always been important for the Church. Why is that? What is its purpose in God's plan? What are some of the controversial topics? How can we address them?


