### INTRODUCING OUR LITURGICAL MINISTRIES : THE MINISTRY OF LECTORS

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

(John 1:1-2)

The proclamation of the Word of God is a sacred ministry in the Church. Lectors bring the living Word of God to the liturgical assembly. In and through them God speaks to the gathered faithful.

It is the Holy Spirit who proclaims God's Word through the Lector. The Lector's responsibility is to prepare well. Spiritual preparation involves prayer over the text and reflection on its message. It involves understanding the text and interpreting it sufficiently so as to evoke a response from the assembly.

Practical preparation involves mastering difficult words, learning the right pronunciations, and practicing the delivery of the text aloud. Effective proclamation involves delivery of the message with clarity, conviction, and appropriate pace.



The Ministry of Lectors of our parish conducts practice and reflection on the Word of God on the 2nd and 4th Friday evenings of the month. Other activities include:

- (1) Days of Recollection to help deepen our faith;
- (2) Quarterly visits to homes of Lectors and annual Family Day gathering to foster friendship and fellowship through fun-filled activities and
- (3) Biennial General Meeting to conduct election of office bearers

Those who are committed to serving the community; interested to share their talent and prepared to set aside the time for preparation and formation are welcome to join The Ministry of Lectors.


#### PIETA Singapore (Tue 28 Feb @ 7.30 pm)


