## **Corpus Christi**

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (in latin: Corpus Christi) honours the real presence of he body (Corpus) of Jesus Christ in he bread and wine of the Eucharist. which is the centre and summit of our faith.

To commemorate this Feast Day,

- a) the Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) will renew their commitment and pledge at the Sunset Mass;
- b) the children will receive their First Holy Communion at the 5.30 pm Mass on Sunday; and
- c) we will have the traditional procession of Corpus Christi after the 5.30 pm Mass.






