Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Fri 8 Sept)

To commemorate the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Legion of Mary will be distributing flowers this weekend for parishioners to place at Our Lady's statues. Love offerings are welcome.

On Sun 10 Sept, the rosary will be prayed before all Masses.

The Most Holy Name of Mary (Tue 12 Sept)

The Feast of the Most Holy Name of Mary falls on the 12th of Sept, four days after the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We are encouraged to pray for our Blessed Mother's intercession to foster a deeper relationship with her beloved Son, our Lord.

Our Lady of Sorrows (Fri 15 Sept)

"Our Lady of Sorrows" portrays our Blessed Mother's suffering and grief during the passion and death of our Lord.

"This child [Jesus] is destined to be the downfall and the rise of many in Israel, a sign that will be opposed—and you yourself shall be pierced with a sword—so that the thoughts of many hearts may be laid bare" (Luke 2:34-35).
