### **Ordinary Time**

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on Mon 8 Jan is a milestone in the liturgical calendar of the Church. It closes the Christmas season. begins Jesus' ministry and starts Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time is the season of life, with prayers and readings focusing on Christ's public life.



The liturgical colour is green, symbolising life, hope and anticipation.

Ordinary Time has an extraordinary purpose. It challenges us to be better Christians and lead lives that make us worthy to be called children of God.

Let God take charge to transform our lives!

### The Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas) (Fri 02 Feb)

The feast of the Presentation of the Lord commemorates Simeon's famous prophecy that Jesus would be a "light of revelation to the Gentiles."

It is also known as Candlemas since it is the day that candles are blessed for use throughout the Church year.



The 6.30 am and 7.15 pm Masses will be held in the main Church. As it is also the First Friday of the month, we will have Holy Hour at 8 pm in the Main Church.

Parishioners can bring their candles to the Parish Office prior to 2 Feb. Please label the candles with your name and contact number. You can collect the candles from the Wardens after the respective Masses. If you are unable to attend the Masses, you can approach the Wardens to collect your candles from the St Joachim Room on weekends.



### **No Dumping on Church Grounds**




As you are spring cleaning your homes, please do not dispose of your unwanted items on the Church premises.


Of late, we have been finding bags of discarded items, many of which are not reusable.


