

Laudato Si Week (19 – 26 May)

Pope Francis has issued two documents, Laudato Si and Laudate Deum, urging us to acknowledge our profound interconnectedness with nature and to respond to the pressing environmental and social challenges we face today.

Cardinal Goh has issued a pastoral letter (a copy can be found on the notice board and in the Catholic News) which highlights our Holy Father's concerns about the climate crisis and urges us to act and work towards care of our common home as stewards of God's creation.







