Elderly Parishioners

Elderly parishioners will be contacted by the Parish Office on their attendance and bus arrangements.

Wheelchair Bound

Wheelchair invitees and their caregivers will be contacted directly by the PFS Organising Committee.

Balloting for Papal Mass Tickets

Please note following timings:

- Registration for the ballot to get a Papal Mass ticket is from now till 31 July 2024. This is done only on myCatholicSG.
- Ballot results will come out in the first week of August.
- Tickets will be issued via myCatholicSG in early September 2024.

Please register yourself as individuals first. Come 1 July, form groups between registered individuals to ballot as a GROUP, if you want to be seated together at the Mass.

Those who have volunteered or been invited do not need to register for ballot. Your myCatholicSG accounts will be updated by 15 July to reflect either your seat or your volunteer role.

Papal Mass Updates (cont'd)

Scams and Fraud

Please be wary of scammers who claim to be helping with the Papal Mass ticket registration. Approach only reliable sources for assistance.

Scammers, having gained access to the WhatsApp accounts of those on your contact list, masquerade as your contacts and ask you to generate and send them a WhatsApp verification code on the pretext of helping you with the Mass ticket registration. They then use this code to hijack your Whatsapp account, gaining access to your contact list to perpetuate the scam.

When someone sends you a code to ask you to key it in, please verify the authenticity of the request.

Please note that WhatsApp or other instant messaging apps such as SMS or Telegram will not be used in general ticketing or balloting processes.
