Feast of the Holy Family



The Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, serves as a poignant reminder of the importance of family in our Christian faith. By honoring the Holy Family, the Church presents them as a model and patron for all Christian families, inspiring us to emulate their love, devotion, and obedience.

As we reflect on the Holy Family, parents are reminded of their sacred duty to love, nurture, and guide their children, while children are encouraged to obey and honor their parents with love and respect, in thought, word, and deed. The example of Jesus, who was obedient to Mary and Joseph, teaches us the value of humility, respect, and selflessness within our family relationships.



Jubilee Year 2025 - Pilgrims of Hope

Pope Francis opened the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica on Christmas Eve thereby officially inaugurating the 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope. It will continue until the closing of the Holy Door on 6 January 2026, the solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord.



Every 25 years, the Church observes a Jubilee year in honour of the birth of Jesus. For us, Jubilee 2025 is a time of forgiveness and reconciliation, when we are invited to restore our relationship with God and with each other.

Pope Francis has expressed his desire for the People of God to participate fully in the Jubilee's proclamation of hope in God's grace.

As we prepare to enter into 2025, our parish will be organising a number of events to celebrate the Jubilee Year including a Lenten Walk to the Holy Door as well as a Pilgrimage to Rome.

The Cathedral of the Good Shepherd will be the local pilgrimage site for the Archdiocese of Singapore throughout the Holy Year. Cardinal William Goh will be celebrating the opening Mass for the beginning of the Jubilee Year in Singapore on Sat 28 Dec. Year End Gathering (Tue 31 Dec @ 6.45 pm)




