The Baptism of the Lord

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the beginning of Jesus' ministry and confirms his identity as the Son of God.

The events surrounding Christ's baptism hold profound symbolism for our own baptismal experience. Just as the Holy Spirit descended upon Christ, the Trinity takes up residence in our soul at our baptism. Christ was affirmed as the 'Beloved Son' of the Father; similarly,



we become adopted children of God through baptism. The heavens opened at Christ's baptism, and in our own baptism, the gates of heaven are opened to us. As Jesus prayed at His baptism, we too must commit to a life of prayer after our baptism, seeking to avoid sin and remain faithful to our newfound identity as children of God.

This Feast day closes the Christmas Season and opens Ordinary Time, the season of life.

Couplets for Chinese New Year (Sun 12 Jan)




WPCU (Tue 21 Jan @ 8 pm)






