




Mural on the Scriptural Stations of the Cross



You would have noticed the mural that was installed on Fri 17 Jan 2025 at the foyer facing the Adoration Room.

Background

The Stations of the Cross depicts Jesus' journey from Gethsemane to Calvary.

There are many variations of the Stations of the Cross. In the traditional version, only nine of the 14 stations are explicitly mentioned in the Bible. Pope John Paul II introduced the Scriptural Stations of the Cross on Good Friday in 1991, featuring stations entirely grounded in Scripture.

In 2013, Sacred Heart Church in Samford, Australia commissioned the artist to paint the 14 Stations of the Cross. The commission took 16 months to complete.

The 14 Stations have been prayerfully painted on the 1.2 m tall wooden kneelers stripped from the old church pews. Each Station panel was made by bracing two kneelers together in the same way early Christian icon panels were braced in the 3rd and 4th Century. The use of the kneelers brings to mind the prayers of anguish Christ prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane before His crucifixion. The worn edges, cracks and nail holes were deliberately retained to symbolise Christ's suffering.

The artwork's colors also hold deep meaning: white for Christ's purity, earth tones for His humanity, gold for His divinity, and wood grain symbolizing the cross.

When the Stations of the Cross are placed side by side, the top and bottom landscape lines begin to emerge like a rhythm flowing from left to right. The crosses at the top of each panel are meticulously hand carved and form the shape of the top landscape. The lower hills are filled with angular lettering, naming the individual stations.

Artist Biography

Dianne Minnaar is a professional artist and calligrapher with over 35 years experience. After graduating with Biblical Studies and Graphic Fine Art degrees in Cape Town, South Africa, she immigrated to Australia in 2001, where she currently resides.

According to Mrs. Minnaar, the artwork's fragmented design represents the brokenness of human life, transformed and made whole through Jesus Christ's redemptive sacrifice on the cross.


Commissioning of Lectors on Sunday of the Word of God (Sun 26 Jan @ 11.30 am Mass)






