About the Mission

In November 2024, Typhoon Marce wreaked havoc in the region, leaving over 40,000 individuals displaced and their homes destroyed, leaving them desperate for help and hope.

What We Will Do

As we approach Lent, a time of reflection, sacrifice and service, we emulate Christ by bringing essential aid to those most in need, rebuild their school, homes, bringing hope and some joy back into their lives.

End with a Pilgrimate to Our Lady of Piat

We end the mission with a pilgrimage of thanksgiving and presentation of petitions to the shrine of the centuries old image of Our Lady of Piat that was visited by Pope Francis in 2023.


