Jubilee Prayer



Last weekend, we shared the Jubilee Prayer in the bulletin. Moving forward, we will recite this prayer at all Masses on the second Sunday of every month. By doing so, we unite with Catholics worldwide to pray for God's guidance and strength amidst global challenges such as war, the pandemic, and the climate crisis.

It is also our Holy Father's hope that the Jubilee will "be a moment of genuine, personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the "door" (cf. Jn 10:7.9) of our salvation, whom the Church is charged to proclaim always, everywhere and to all as "our hope" (1 Tim 1:1)."

In Singapore, the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd has been designated as the local pilgrimage site for the Archdiocese of Singapore during this Jubilee Year. A special shrine featuring the Crucifix of Hope, a large and ornate cross, has been erected in the south transept of the Cathedral. We invite you to make it a point to visit the Cathedral and pray at this shrine during this year-long celebration.

Preparation for Lent

Collection of Palms

Parishioners can deposit their blessed palms (from the previous year) in the boxes that have been placed at the Statue of St Joseph in the main Church.







How is the book relevant?


In calling for Jubilee 2025 with the theme "Pilgrims of Hope", Pope Francis writes: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision." Given St Joseph's faithfulness despite being confronted with ample challenges as the fosterfather of Jesus, he exemplifies what it means to be a pilgrim of hope. He is a model of the open spirit, trusting heart and farsighted vision that the Holy Father speaks of.

The Priests of the Parish are presenting every family with a copy of the book, The Way of the Cross with St Joseph: A Virtues-based Personal Devotion for Healing and Reconciliation, to aid your prayer during this special year. You can collect your copy after all Masses on 01 – 02 March.

What is the book about?

The book offers the reader a fresh perspective of the Way of the Cross by considering St Joseph's life and influence on the child Jesus alongside that of Jesus's final journey. Adopting a virtues-based approach, it considers the practical aspects of Christian living and advocates for the restoration of relationships with self, others and God. These virtues are summarised on pages 144 and 145.




Creating Safe Spaces (22 - 23 Mar)


