## From the Desk of the Parish Priest

### Lent



Ash Wednesday marks the start of the 40-day Lenten season, a time of reflection, repentance, and spiritual renewal.

### Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting and abstinence are spiritual disciplines that help cultivate love for God and others.

#### Fasting :

Catholics between 18 and 59 years old are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting involves eating smaller portions - typically two half-meals and one full meal - with no snacks in between.

#### Abstinence :

Catholics aged 14 and above must abstain from meat every Friday throughout the year and not just during Lent. Exceptions are made when a Solemnity falls on a Friday or when a dispensation is granted (e.g., Chinese New Year). If one cannot observe abstinence, an alternative form of penance should be chosen.

### The Significance of Ashes

The use of ashes has ancient roots, symbolizing mourning, mortality, and penance in the Old Testament. The ashes used on Ash Wednesday come from burning the blessed palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday celebration.

When the priest or minister marks the forehead with ashes, they say either : "Remember that you are dust and unto dust you shall return" or "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

The tradition connects the beginning of Lent with the approach of Holy Week and Easter.

### The Three Pillars of Lent

Lent is built on three pillars:

1. Prayer: Deepening our relationship with God through prayer and devotion.
2. Fasting: Practicing self-denial and detachment from worldly desires.
3. Almsgiving: Showing compassion and kindness to others through acts of charity.

### Conclusion

May our observance of this Lenten season prepare us for the joyful celebration of Easter. Have a spirit-filled and meaningful Lent.

### Cemetery and Chapel of the Resurrection

St Joseph’s Church in Bukit Timah (SJCBT) had a cemetery behind the church for about 130 years from the 1850s to 1980s. This cemetery had been home for early departed parishioners and priests from Missions Etrangères de Paris (MEP).

Our cemetery had ten tombstones of MEP priests who had died in Singapore. Three tombstones were for MEP priests who were parish priests of SJCBT: Fr Anatole Mauduit (1817-1858), who built our Kranji chapel in 1846 and Bukit Timah church in 1853; Fr Elisee Delouette (1848-1897), who served SJCBT from 1872-1876; and Fr Jean-Marie Belliot (1848-1934), who led SJCBT from 1878-1934.

Five tombstones were for MEP missionaries who had died in Singapore: Fr Joseph Alibert (1835-1868), a missionary in Hainan; Fr Claude Tisserand (1809-1870), Rector of the College General regional seminary in Penang; Fr Gustave Derenne (1841-1870), a missionary in Cochín-China; Fr Alexandre Blanchet (1870-1896), who died while en route to Kwangtung; and Fr Christophe Mazery (1840-1900), who served at the Church of the Immaculate Conception in Penang and Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Church in Taiping.

Two tombstones were for MEP missionaries who died in the 1970s: Monsignor Michel Olcomendy (1901-1977), who was Archbishop of Malacca in 1953 and then of Singapore in 1972; and Fr Rene Girard (1903-1978), who held various positions in Malaya and Singapore, including as Personal Secretary to Archbishop Michel Olcomendy.

Fr Mauduit was initially buried in the nave of the church, but his remains were shifted several times: First to the cemetery in 1962 during the second phase of construction of the main body of the new church and later to the Chapel of the Resurrection in 1996. Fr Mauduit’s gravestone was then restored and placed in the Rosary Garden in 2016.

The remains of the MEP priests buried in the cemetery were exhumed and their ashes placed in SJCBT’s Chapel of the Resurrection. The remains of Archbishop Olcomendy were interred at the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd.

The transition from cemetery to Chapel of the Resurrection was a difficult period for our parish. As part of Singapore’s growth development, the old cemetery had closed for burials in 1984 and became State Land in 1987. The government also acquired the front portion of the church in 1988 for drainage and road widening.

In 1990, the parish tried unsuccessfully to buy back the lost cemetery land and build a Memorial Garden-cum-Columbarium. After a few years, the parish obtained approval to complete the Chapel of the Resurrection and columbarium niches on our own land behind the church in 1995, with official opening and blessing by Archbishop Gregory Yong. The cost of building the Chapel of the Resurrection had doubled to \$570,000. In addition, the parish had to re-purchase part of the cemetery land for parking spaces for the Chapel of the Resurrection.

The Chapel of the Resurrection was expanded with a parlour and four new blocks of niches in 2016, providing nearly 1800 niches in total. The parlour is fully air-conditioned with a seating capacity for 100-120 people and plenty of parking spaces. All the blocks for the niches are named after Apostles.

When you visit the Chapel of the Resurrection to pay respects to ancestors and loved ones, do also pray for the departed interred at the St John Block. There, you will see the niches of local parish priest Fr Simon Yim (who served SJCBT between 1977-1985 and died on 6 September 2002 aged 81); the Gabrielite Brothers (who taught in our schools and helped our parish in various ways); and the MEP priests (who left the comforts of home in France to spread the Catholic faith in Singapore and the region). Say also a prayer for other MEP and local priests who were buried or interred elsewhere in Singapore and overseas. Thank God for giving our parish a modern resting place for departed souls.

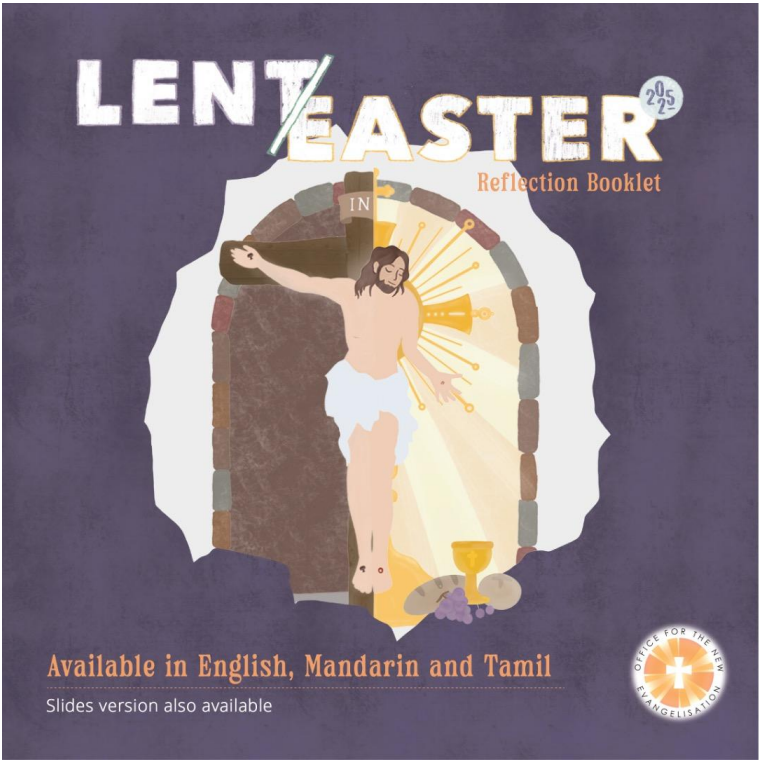

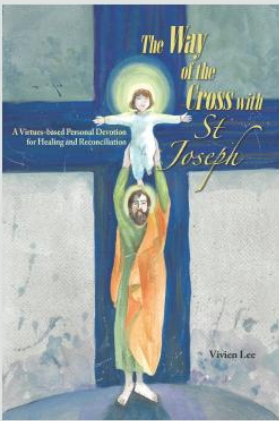

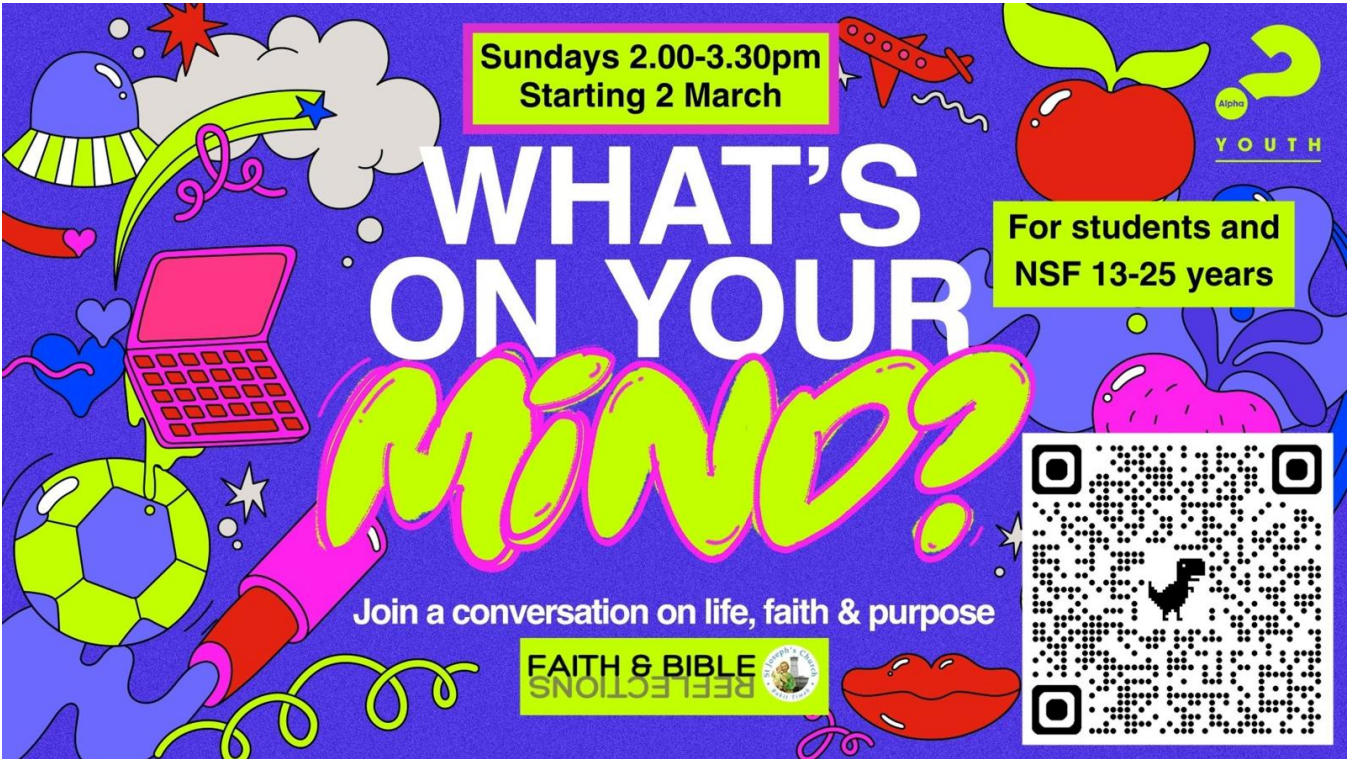


Assisi Fun Day : Ticket Sales (01 – 02 Mar)



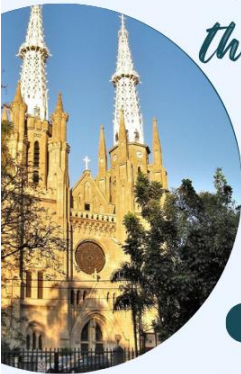
