
The Cathedral of the Good Shepherd is the local pilgrimage site for the Archdiocese of Singapore throughout the Holy Year.

OYP is back with its next run of Seeds of Growth — happening over two Saturdays in April for all Alevels/IB students!


There'll be worship, faith formation sessions, prayer, and fellowship. Come and grow in friendship with God, and fellow A-levels/IB students!


The Foundation runs more than 28 shelters altogether, catering to the differing needs of former street children until they become independent.



CJC Lenten Evening (Fri 11 Apr @ 5.15 pm)




Catholic Junior College (CJC) warmly invites all Catholic youth aged 15 to 19 to participate in Lenten Evening 2025!


